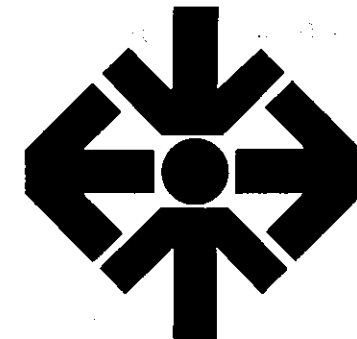

INTRODUCTION

The primary purpose of the Directory is to make it possible for the members of the Association to become better acquainted with one another, to know more about their scope, interests, and qualifications, to assist them in making contacts that will better co-ordinate activities and developments in special interest areas, and to improve employment opportunities. In addition, as the Directory is made available to libraries, organisations and associations it broadens the possibility for contact by non-members who are interested in the Association and its members.

The information contained in the Directory was obtained directly from the members of the Association. Effort was made to follow their submissions as nearly as possible with a minimum of editing. This necessitated resisting the temptation to standardise and codify some of the material, especially the areas of special interest. Given the nature of sociology and variable definitions and shadings of specialisations, it was decided to present the areas of interest as submitted but to place them so as to make them easily identifiable.
