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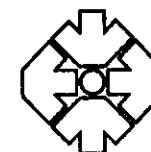

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Foreword

The SAANZ Membership Directory, through its two previous editions, has been a useful means of assisting sociologists in Australia and New Zealand to become aware of each other and the areas of interest they have in common. This third edition has made some changes in the format and one new major feature has been added. However, its main purpose remains the same and our hope is that this edition will assist members to keep in touch and locate others with like interests.

Questions have arisen from time to time about the composition of the Association. Although the information has been in the directory it has not been readily accessible. I have analysed some of the details which have been at issue at meetings of the association and may which prove of assistance in the future.

The number of members listed in the directory is 585 of whom 68% are male. More than half of the members (57%) are not in University Departments, although 66.5% are engaged in tertiary teaching. The analysis of employment is as follows:

It may also be of interest that 10% of members declined to divulge their year of birth. There were exactly 26 of each sex, which represents 16% of females and 7% of males.

The use of the word "sociology" has been avoided where possible but should be assumed as the context in which all areas of interest are set. For instance, an area of interest listed as "urban" should be understood to mean "urban sociology". "Women" has been used as a classification by the majority of people listing this area. However, I take no responsibility for its implications. All addresses are 'Australia' unless otherwise indicated.

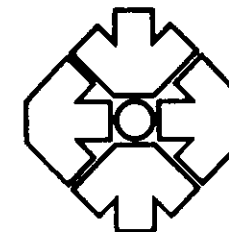
