PREFACE

This fifth edition of the SAANZ Membership Directory follows the same form and serves the same functions as past editions, viz to assist Australian and New Zealand sociologists to be aware of each others' backgrounds, recent work histories and, most importantly, common interests, thus helping to promote communication and research in sociology. Similarly, the Directory serves to inform others who might wish to commission research by members of those with interest in the various areas.

This edition also follows the initiative introduced in the fourth edition, providing tabular information on country and state of employment of members and a more detailed analysis of academic institutions employing sociologists.

The layout of this Directory omits reference to sex; it enables cross reference from area of interest to personal entry. The personal entry contains members surnames, title, other names, year of birth (where volunteered), qualifications, areas of interest and recent job history. Areas of interest have been expressed to avoid repeated use of the word "sociology", and should be interpreted as referring to sociology. Recent job histories show only the last position held, but where a member has held more than one position in the same institution, the year of first employment in that institution is shown. In the same vein, reference to Australia in members' addresses has been omitted to save costs.

The Directory is provided free to all members of the Sociological Association of Australia and New Zealand. It is available to non-members upon receipt of remittance of \$5.00 by the Honorary Secretary, SAANZ, c/- Department of Education, Brisbane College of Advanced Education, Kelvin Grove Campus, Victoria Park Road, Kelvin Grove, Qld 4059.
