CANBERRA SOCIOLOGICAL SOCIETY

CONSTITUTION

1. The Society shall be known as the Canberra Sociological Society.
2. The object of the Society shall be to promote interest in sociology, in particular by the holding of meetings and by entering into contact with other bodies concerned with sociology.
3. Membership is open to all persons interested in sociology.
4. The Society shall be administered by a Committee comprising a President, Secretary-Treasurer, and not less than three and not more than five other members, to be elected at an annual general meeting.
5. There shall be an annual membership fee. The fee for the first year shall be five shillings and thereafter shall be determined annually.
